



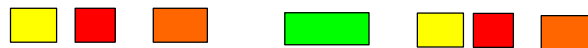
Colour	Grammar form	Number of building blocks
Green	Conjunction	1
Orange	Adjective	2
Blue	Noun	1
Yellow	Subject	2
Red	Verb	3
White	Preposition	1

<b>Conjunction</b>	A word used to connect sentences (e.g. and, but, if).
<b>Adjective</b>	Adjectives are describing words.
<b>Noun</b>	It may be a thing, a person or a place.
<b>Subject</b>	A subject is who or what a sentence is about.
<b>Verb</b>	A verb is what the subject is doing.
<b>Prepositions</b>	A word that is used before a noun, a noun phrase, or a pronoun, connecting it to another word.

You need to form sentences and place the coloured blocks above the words that you think are the conjunctions, adjectives, nouns, subjects, verbs and prepositions.

All sentences must have:

1. Capital letters
2. Full stops
